Disclaimer

The Beast @ Betteshanger 2018

Please read and bring a signed copy of this disclaimer with you to your booked session on The Beast at Betteshanger.

Your signed disclaimer will be exchanged for a wristband that will allow you to access The Beast at your booked time.

A disclaimer must be completed by everyone in your party.

If you are accompanying a child under the age of 18 years, you will need to sign a disclaimer on their behalf.

1 SAFETY – KEY RESTRICTIONS AND OBLIGATIONS

- 1.1 The Beast comprises of a large inflatable course and participation is not without risk of injury due to the nature of the physical activity required to complete the course.
- 1.2 Only persons who are at least 10 years of age are permitted to go on The Beast. It is your responsibility to ensure that all members of your party meet this age restriction (proof of age may be required on the day you attend The Beast).
- 1.3 Any persons aged 10-16 years MUST be accompanied, on the inflatable, by an adult.
- 1.4 No food or drink can be consumed on The Beast.
- 1.5 We reserve the right to refuse admittance to The Beast or to remove a participant from The Beast without refund or compensation should we deem it necessary to do so. This includes, any participant who:
 - 1.5.1 is under the age of 10 years old;
 - 1.5.2 is found to be consuming food or drink on The Beast;
 - 1.5.3 does not comply with any safety rules made known to them by our representatives on the day of your participation on The Beast;
 - 1.5.4 is deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs; and/or
 - 1.5.5 behaves in an inappropriate manner.

2 HEALTH DISCLAIMER

The Beast is physically demanding and requires a degree of agility, strength and stamina. Ticket holder (s) accept that this activity is dangerous and can result in Death and/or injury. It is your responsibility to take any medical condition(s) and/or limitations you have into account and to ensure that you do not go beyond your personal limits when on The Beast. If you have any doubts about whether you should take part on The Beast, you should seek advice from your doctor. No refunds or compensation will be payable by us in the event that you do decide not to partake or complete The Beast due to health reasons.

3 CLOTHING

- 3.1 It is the responsibility of all participants to ensure they are dressed appropriately bearing in mind the nature of The Beast and the weather conditions on the day of your attendance.
- 3.2 No shoes, boots or footwear are to be worn on The Beast (only socks or bare feet are permitted) and participants shall be asked to remove such footwear before going on The Beast.
- 3.3 We shall not be responsible for any damage and/or loss to clothing or to other personal items resulting from participation on The Beast.

In addition you are reminded that whilst on The Beast you must:

- Remove all keys, loose jewellery and mobile phones (we will keep them safe)
- Keep moving forward and not double back
- Not barge or deliberately knock into other participants
- Help each other over the higher obstacles
- Alert a steward immediately if you feel ill or injure yourself.
